Category Grouping

- Elite Men Cat 1,2,3 Will race and score together.
- Elite Women Cat 1,2,3 Will race and scored together. You may be combined with either the Master Men or Cat 3, 4 Men Elite Women for start group but still separated for results.
- **Master Men** Will race and scored together. You may be combined with either the Elite Women or Cat 3, 4 for start group but still separated for results.
- **Cat 3, 4 Men** Will race together and score together. You may be combined with either Elite Women or Master Men for start group but still separated for results.
- **Cat 4, 5 Men** Will race and score together. You may be combined with the Cat 3, 4, 5 Women for start group but still separated for results.
- **Cat 3, 4, 5 Women** Will race and score together. You may be combined with the Cat 4, 5 Men for start group but still separated for results.

Category Info, UCI Rules, Licenses, Upgrade Points, Category Info

- This race will follow UCI road race guidelines. There will be commissaires on course to enforce these guidelines to ensure a safe, competitive, fair play environment for all participants. It is the responsibility of all riders to know the rules set-out by the UCI.
- You must have a Master license to race in the Master category.
- UCI or Cycling BC Provincial License required. One day licenses only available for Cat 5.
- Upgrade points. Please contact Cycling BC directly for more information.

Numbers

• You will receive jersey and bike numbers. Number placement will be announced prior to the race. The frame number is to be mounted on the seat post. Please bring your own pins for the number.

Course Information

- The course is 18 km is comprised of flats, descents and significant climbs/ flats. The race will go in a clockwise direction.
- All bikes must be road style drop bar bikes and conform to UCI bike rules. No mountain bikes or flat bars. Bikes cannot have fenders, racks, mirrors or other accessories that may pose a safety risk to the race. No E-bikes allowed in any category.
- The course will be marked along with Traffic Marshals in place. The roads are open to the public, so please ride responsibly, be courteous to those you encounter, do not litter. **IT IS THE RIDERS REPSONSIBILITY TO KNOW THE COURSE.**

• While on the paved roads, centre line rule is in effect. It is recommended to ride close to the right side of the road at all times. Dropped riders must ride single file on the right side of the road.

Race Day Package Pick-Up, Sign-On and Waivers

- Sign-in closes 30 minutes prior to start time.
- You will be issued them on-site. Please bring your own pins.
- All waivers have been signed on-line. No paper copies required.

Parking

- Parking will be along Seux Road and Pattison Road. You will need to enter the parking and staging area via Pattison Road. Please park closely together to allow space for others. To park, please stay on Sylvester Road, drive past Seux Road, Turn Left on Pattison then left on Seux Road. You will not be allowed to enter via Seux Road and Sylvester.
- Please respect the local properties and leave no garbage behind. This includes apple cores, banana peals etc. Team Tents can set-up on the school grounds.

Washrooms

Rider Behavior

- All riders are to conduct themselves in a professional, respectable manner at all times. Any rider, parent, coach or spectator who display's abusive and/or violent actions, uses foul language, or who's behavior is deemed inappropriate will be disqualified from the event and asked to leave the area. Further disciplinary actions may be taken.
- There is to be no littering or urinating in public places. Fines and/or disqualifications will occur.
- Helmets are to be worn anytime you are on a bike.
- Riders are only allowed to race in the category and start wave they are registered in. There is to be no racing with other groups outside of this. If you are passed by another category group during the race, you must let it pass and continue on your own. If you join that race group, you will not get a result.
- If you are dropped, you must keep to the right side of the road. No riding side-by-side.

- Centre line rule is in effect at all times.
- Once your race is done, you must immediately exit the finish line area. There is to be no standing or loitering near the finish.

Feed Zones, Litter Zones and Mechanical Support

- Feed Zone will be on Stave Lake Road North of Durieu Road. It will be marked with cones. Do not park on the course or in private driveways. It is recommended to walk or ride a bike to the feed zone from the main parking area to reduce vehicle traffic in the area. More specifics on when feeding will be allowed will be directed to the riders before the start of their races.
- Litter Zones will be marked before and after the feedzones. Please use these areas only to discard bottles and other items. You must remove them from the litter zone post race.
- **There is no neutral mechanical support for this race.** It is the responsibility of all riders to be self sufficient on the course. Wheel service is available at the feed zone.

Time-Cuts

• Time cuts maybl be in effect. You will be notified of the time prior to your race. If you are outside of the time limit, you will be stopped once crossing the finish line. You will get a result. Everyone will finish on the same lap as the winner in your category.

Results, Podiums and Prizes

- Top 5 results will be announced at the end of the race. There will be a 15 minute time limit to protest these results. Podiums will proceed immediately after this time. Only top 3 riders will be on the podium and must attend the ceremony in full podium attire. Failure to do so will result in forfeit of prizing. Prizing will be given out at the podium ceremonies. Final results will be posted within 24 hours at <u>www.localride.ca</u>. Full results may not be available on site.
- Prizing will be determined according to registration numbers. This will be listed no later than May 31. If less than 8 riders in a category, prizing will only be given to winner.
